Ponies

All classes are to be pre-entered and there will be a drawn order for the first 2 classes of the day (the order and start-time can be found on Colraine web-site from 6pm on Saturday). Written entries to be submitted to Colraine by Noon on the day before (e-mail accepted) and if possible accompanied with the correct fees. Total show entries will be limited and will be accepted on a first come first served basis. All substitutions are acceptable.

Class 1: Pony British Novice.

For registered ponies. Rule 410. Table A7. Speed 325mpm Height 80cm. Rule 77.12 & 77.13 applies.
Entry Fee: £13 Prizes: £20 £14 £13 £13

Class 2: Pony Discovery/90cms Open.

For registered ponies in JC/JD which have not won a total of £175 to be ridden by Pony or Pony Associate members. Rule 408. Table A7. Speed 325mpm. Rule 77.12 & 77.13 applies in the Discovery section. This class will be split in the event of 30 or more starters. Ponies may compete in one section only.
Entry Fee: £13 Prizes £20 £14 £13 £13

Class 3: Blue Chip Feed Balancer Pony Newcomers/1m Open.

For registered ponies. Rule 406. Table A7. Speed 325mpm. This class will be split in the event of 30 or more starters. Ponies may compete in one section only.
Entry Fee: £14 Prizes £25 £20 £16 £14
First rosette sponsored by Blue Chip Feed Balancer.

Class 4: Squibb Demolition Pony Foxhunter/1.10m Open

For registered ponies Rule 404 Table A7. Speed 325mpm. This class will be split in the event of 30 or more starters. Ponies may compete in one section only
Entry Fee: £15 Prizes £30 £25 £20 £15
First rosette sponsored by Squibb Demolition.

The organiser reserves the right to alter the schedule at any time should it be necessary, to refuse entry and to cancel any class should there be insufficient entries received. In the event of insufficient starters, prizes will be awarded as per rule 76.6.1. No member shall allow a stallion for which he/she is responsible as owner, lessee, authorised agent or rider to compete or be prepared to compete, in any show jumping competition without taking adequate precautions to ensure other members of the public are not put at risk of injury.
