For registered ponies in JC/JD which have not won a total of £175 to be ridden by Pony or Pony Associate members. Rule408. Table A7. Speed 325mpm. This class will be split in the event of 30 or more starters. Ponies may compete in one section only. Regional points will be awarded in the open section in KP Media League Tables.

Class P3: Blue Chip Feed Balancer Pony Newcomers/1m Open.

For registered ponies. Rule 406. Table A7. Speed 325mpm. This class will be split in the event of 30 or more starters. Ponies may compete in one section only. Regional points will be awarded in the Open section in KP Media League Tables.

Class P4: The Bath & West Junior Open Championships.

For registered ponies to be ridden by Pony or Pony Associate members. Table A7. Speed 325mpm. Height of fences for qualifiers will not exceed 1.10m in the first round. Height of fences for the final will not exceed 1.15m in the first round. The first 4 ponies to qualify within the first 6 placings will qualify for The Royal Bath & West Show 2010.. Qualification does not go past 6th place. Ponies must jump clear in the first round. Restricted to competitors from the following areas 35, 41, 42, 43, 48, 49, 50, 51.
