Total show entries will be limited and will be accepted on a first come first served basis. All substitutions are acceptable.

### Class A3: 1.05m Open.

For registered horses to be ridden by Full, Associate or Pony Associate members. Table A7. Speed 325mpm.

### Class A4: EquestrianClearance.com Senior Newcomers incorporating The Royal Bath & West Novice Championship First Round.

For registered horses. Rule 312. Table A7. Speed 325mpm.

The Royal Bath & West Qualifier is for registered horses which have not won a total of £300 on the day of qualifier and must be in Grade C at the time of the final. Riders not to be in top 100 of ranking list 349 at time of qualifying.

Qualified horses to be ridden in the final by person who qualified them. Restricted to horses ridden by British Showjumping members in areas 35, 41, 42, 43, 48, 49, 50 and 51. Height of fences 1.10m in the first round. Table A7. Speed 325 mpm.

Qualifiers must jump clear in the first round. The first six will qualify for the final at The Royal Bath & West Show 2012. Qualification does not pass down the line.

For registered horses. Table A7. Speed 325mpm.

The Royal Bath & West Qualifier is for registered horses. Riders not to be in top 50 of ranking list 349. Qualified horses to be ridden in the final by person who qualified them. Restricted to horses ridden by British Showjumping members in areas 35, 41, 42, 43, 48, 49, 50 and 51. Height of fences 1.25m in the first round and 1.30m in the final. Table A7. Speed 325 mpm. Qualifiers must jump clear in the first round. The first six will qualify for the final at The Royal Bath & West Show 2012. Qualification does not pass down the line.

The organiser reserves the right to alter the schedule at any time should it be necessary, to refuse entry and to cancel any class should there be insufficient entries received. No member shall allow a stallion for which he/she is responsible as owner, lessee, authorised agent or rider to compete or be prepared to compete, in any show jumping competition without taking adequate precautions to ensure other members of the public are not put at risk of injury.
