For registered horses to be ridden by Full, Associate or Pony Associate members excluding the top 450 on BSJA Riders Ranking List No. 327 (1st Aug 08 – 31st July 09). Riders who have ever competed as a team member of any Senior International Team, (Nations Cup, World, European Championships and Olympic Games) are not eligible. Pony Riders, Children, Juniors and Young Riders who have ever competed in Nations Cup/International Team Events and European Championships in the last five years are not eligible. (Excluding Veteran Teams). Table A7. Speed 325mpm. Rule 320. 1st 6 amateurs to qualify, qualification will not pass down the line and qualifiers must jump clear in the first round. Regional points will be awarded (amateurs only) in the KP Media League Tables.

Class A3: 1.10m Open incorporating 1.10m National Amateur Championship Qualifier - First Round

For registered horses to be ridden by Full, Associate or Pony Associate members excluding the top 250 on BSJA Riders Ranking List No. 327 (1st Aug 08 – 31st July 09). Riders who have ever competed as a team member of any Senior International Team, (Nations Cup, World, European Championships and Olympic Games) are not eligible. Pony Riders, Children, Juniors and Young Riders who have ever competed in Nations Cup/International Team Events and European Championships in the last five years are not eligible. (Excluding Veteran Teams). Table A7. Speed 325mpm. Rule 322. 1st 6 amateurs to qualify, qualification will not pass down the line and qualifiers must jump clear in the first round.

Class A4: 1.15m National Amateur Championship Qualifier - First Round

For registered horses to be ridden by Full, Associate or Pony Associate members excluding the top 150 on BSJA Riders Ranking List No. 327 (1st Aug 08 – 31st July 09). Riders who have ever competed as a team member of any Senior International Team, (Nations Cup, World, European Championships and Olympic Games) are not eligible. Pony Riders, Children, Juniors and Young Riders who have ever competed in Nations Cup/International Team Events and European Championships in the last five years are not eligible. (Excluding Veteran Teams). Table A10 (In the first round the first half of the course to be built at 1.15m). Speed 325mpm. Rule 324. 1st 6 amateurs to qualify, qualification will not pass down the line and qualifiers must jump clear in the first round.
